Q1 What are the chances that you will vote in November's election for Governor? Will you definitely vote, probably vote, are the chances 50/50, or will you probably not vote?

Will definitely vote 96%
Will probably vote 4%

Q2 The candidates for Governor are Democrat Charlie Crist, Republican Rick Scott, and Libertarian Adrian Wyllie. If the election was today, who would you vote for?
