



## Washington Survey Results

**Q1** What are the chances that you will vote in next week's election for Congress and other important offices? Have you already voted, will you definitely vote, will you probably vote, are the chances 50/50, or will you probably not vote?

*Have already voted* ..... 63%  
*Will definitely vote* ..... 35%  
*Will probably vote* ..... 2%  
*Chances are 50/50* ..... 0%  
*Will probably not vote*..... 0%

**Q2** Initiative Measure No. 591 concerns firearms. This measure would prohibit government agencies from confiscating guns or other firearms from citizens without due process or from requiring background checks on firearm recipients unless a uniform national standard is required. If the election was today, would you definitely vote for Initiative 591, probably vote for it, probably vote against it, definitely vote against it, or are you not sure?

*Definitely for* ..... 33%  
*Probably for* ..... 7%  
*Probably against* ..... 7%  
*Definitely against* ..... 45%  
*Not sure* ..... 8%

**Q3** Initiative Measure No. 594 concerns background checks for firearm sales and transfers. This measure would apply currently used criminal and public safety background checks by licensed dealers to all firearm sales and transfers, including gun show and online sales, with specific exceptions. If the election was today, would you definitely vote for Initiative 594, probably vote for it, probably vote against it, definitely vote against it, or are you not sure?

*Definitely for* ..... 56%  
*Probably for* ..... 3%  
*Probably against* ..... 7%  
*Definitely against* ..... 31%  
*Not sure* ..... 3%

**Q4** Does the initiative I-594, to expand background checks to all gun sales, being on the ballot this year make you more or less likely to vote in this election, or does it not make a difference?

*More likely* ..... 34%  
*Less likely* ..... 5%  
*Doesn't make a difference* ..... 60%  
*Not sure* ..... 1%

**Q5** Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of President Barack Obama?

**Q6** Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of the National Rifle Association, also known as the NRA?

**Q7** Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of former Representative Gabby Giffords?

*Favorable* ..... 47%  
*Unfavorable* ..... 17%  
*Not sure* ..... 36%

**Q8** Do you support or oppose prohibiting anyone convicted of stalking or domestic abuse against a dating partner from buying a gun?

*Support* ..... 65%  
*Oppose* ..... 9%  
*Not sure* ..... 26%

**Q9** If your state legislator supported expanding background checks to all gun sales, would that make you more or less likely to vote for them in the next election, or would it not make a difference?

*More likely* ..... 52%  
*Less likely* ..... 30%  
*Wouldn't make a difference* ..... 15%  
*Not sure* ..... 2%

**Q10** Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? 'We can both protect responsible gun owners' Second Amendment rights and still make it more difficult for criminals and other dangerous people to obtain guns.'

*Agree* ..... 72%  
*Disagree* ..... 14%  
*Not sure* ..... 14%

**Q11** On October 24th, a 15-year-old shot five students, killing two, at Marysville High School in Washington State. Has this incident made you more or less likely to vote for the I-594 measure to require comprehensive gun sale background checks, or has it not made a difference?

*More likely* ..... 15%  
*Less likely* ..... 18%  
*Hasn't made a difference* ..... 66%  
*Not sure* ..... 1%

**Q12** In the last presidential election, did you vote for Barack Obama or Mitt Romney?

*Barack Obama* ..... 54%  
*Mitt Romney* ..... 36%  
*Someone else / Don't remember* ..... 11%

**Q13** If you are a woman, press 1. If a man, press 2.

*Woman* ..... 53%  
*Man* ..... 47%

**Q14** If you are a Democrat, press 1. If a Republican, press 2. If you're an independent or identify with another party, press 3.

*Democrat* ..... 41%  
*Republican* ..... 22%  
*Independent / Other* ..... 37%





**Q15** If you are Hispanic, press 1. If white, press 2. If other, press 3.

<i>Hispanic</i> .....	8%
<i>White</i> .....	80%
<i>Other</i> .....	12%

**Q16** If you are 18 to 45 years old, press 1. If 46 to 65, press 2. If you are older than 65, press 3.

<i>18 to 45</i> .....	24%
<i>46 to 65</i> .....	49%
<i>Older than 65</i> .....	27%
